1. Four courses may be "double-counted" on both the undergraduate and graduate transcripts.
 - a. Two of the four must be 500-level courses (all four can be 500 levels, but at least two must be 500-level courses).
 - b. When we talk about these courses, we talk about them as:
 - i. UG courses: appear only on the undergraduate transcript
 - ii. IUG courses: four courses that appear on both the undergraduate and graduate transcript.
 - iii. GR courses: appear only on the graduate transcript.
2. IUG/Graduate students can have up to four 400-level courses on their graduate transcript. Two 400-levels can be IUG courses to count towards both degrees, and two courses will be graduate only courses and will not count towards the undergraduate degree.
3. Every semester, students meet with their advisers complete semester reports.
4. IUG students must maintain 12 credits to be a full-time student.
5. IUG students should NOT activate their intent to graduate when they've completed their undergraduate degree requirements. If they do, they lose the benefit of paying undergraduate tuition.
